



**THE RESIDENCY OF LATIN AMERICA
OF THE CONSEIL DES ARTS DE MONTRÉAL**

- Residency for artists from January 1st to March 30th (3 months)
- Residency for curator from April 1st to May 30th (2 months)

Deadline: August 31st

The Conseil des arts de Montréal offers a residency program at the Darling Foundry for professional visual artists and curator from Latin America. Each resident receives a grant that contributes towards living expenses, travel fees and production costs.

The Darling Foundry, located in Old Montreal (Quebec, Canada), is an alternative visual arts complex with an outstanding architectural design. The Darling Foundry provides various opportunities for research, creation, production, and exhibition. Its multifaceted spaces of over 3500 m² surface provide room for private studios, residency studios, technical workshops, gallery spaces, a restaurant and offices. A studio measuring 60 m² with separate living accommodation and common living spaces are provided. In addition, the curator is given the option to participate in open studio events where a presentation of his research can be organized, studio visits by art professionals, networking events, and excursions.

The residency includes:

- Airfare (max CAN\$1,200)
- A live-in studio for three (artist)/two (curator) months
- A stipend of CAN\$250 per week

The committee ensures fair representation and consideration of artistic specialization, gender, Aboriginal peoples and cultures from around the world.

Applications are evaluated by a committee of experienced arts professionals based on the:

- The quality of the applicant's work;
- The potential impact of the residency on the applicant's career;
- The contribution to the Canadian arts community.

Letter of intent (maximum 500 words): Describing the applicant's practice as well as the program of work he or she intends to undertake and the significance of the residency for his or her work and career.

Curriculum vitae (maximum 5 pages): Indicating the applicant's professional training (educational background, mentors, workshops, etc.); exhibitions, names, and location of galleries, and whether solo or group shows; and other activities related to his or her practice.

Support materials: 20 digital still images representing the applicant's current work (maximum of 2 MB by image). Applicants may also submit a video (10 minutes maximum) and press reviews or publications.
