## POLICY OF USE OF PRODUCTION WORKSHOPS OF DARLING FOUNDRY

An essential place of creation and diffusion in visual arts, the Darling Foundry enriches its activities by acquiring a multidisciplinary and highly equipped production site. The new production workshops, made available to professional artists, give them the opportunity to explore new techniques and open their practice to other mediums.

## **1. SERVICES OFFER**

#### - WORKING STATIONS

## WOOD STATION

Saw bench, mounting module, jigsaw, milling machine, wood planer, band saw, belt sander, eccentric sander, radial miter saw, assortment of clamps, drill press, manual and pneumatic tools, nail gun and pneumatic staple gun.

#### **METAL STATION**

Metal Band Saw, Heavy Bench Grinder, Semi-Automatic Welder, Cut-off Saw, Angular Grinder

## **CNC STATION**

Computer cutting machine for woodworking, metal and plastic

## **STATION PAINTING**

Ventilation chamber, turbine spray gun, compressor

## **CERAMIC STATION**

Ceramic kiln

#### - TRAINING PROGRAMS

To support artists in their research, training programs are offered regularly throughout the year at affordable prices.

## - ACCOMPANYING

#### - BASIC SECURITY

The users will have to follow introductory and safety session to gain access to the production workshops.

#### - SPECIALIZED TECHNICIANS

The users will have access to specialized technicians available to provide additional support.

#### - PAYMENT METHOD

Users must have paid in full their membership in order to make a reservation request.

## - CAPACITY

Each workstation can accommodate a maximum of one (1) user at a time.

## 4. CONDITIONS OF USE

## - NATURE OF PROJECTS

The Darling Foundry's production workshops are only accessible to professional visual artists for projects related to their practice.

## - SECURITY

In order to be able to use the services of the production workshops, the users must obligatorily follow an introductory session on the safety and use of the workshop. By using the services of production workshops, users declare themselves able to use the tools safely. It is strictly forbidden to smoke, to consume alcohol or drugs in the premises. It is obligatory to:

- wear safety glasses
- wear earplugs for machines that produces high noise levels
- wear a respirator if the work creates particles that may be dangerous for the respiratory tract
- wear appropriate gloves depending on the type of material used

- for the metal station, wear the necessary equipments to perform the welding: gloves, mask, apron, etc.

- wear proper clothing: closed shoes (sandals are forbidden), hair tied, avoid loose clothing as well as necklaces, scarves, earrings, etc.

The user must check that nobody is in his work perimeter, and must read the instruction manual of a tool before using it.

If a tool is non-functional or unsafe, the user must immediately stop using it and notify the technician in place.

In case of non-compliance with safety rules, the user will be evicted from the premises immediately.

## - HOURS

The user undertakes to respect the schedules of the production workshops as well as the booking periods.

## - USE OF TOOLS

By using the services of production workshops, users declare themselves able to use the tools safely. The tools can only be used in production workshops. The user will have to clean the tools after use as well as the surrounding space and the storage of the materials used. Tools should be turned off after use. The user will have to obtain hardware materials for the use of the production workshops.

## - PERSONAL EFFECTS

The Darling Foundry will not be held responsible for any personal effects forgotten. Storage space for personal effects can be made available to the user on demand.
